Governor Corzine has proposed a fiscally responsible budget that provides for a 70% contribution to Public Employee Pension Funds. Although this is a significant contribution and a departure from the irresponsible fiscal practices of the past - it is still 30% short of what the State's Public Employee Benefits Review Task Force recommended. With this in mind, certain legislators are considering reducing Governor Corzine's proposed contribution. We need to send them a message that short changing our retirement is not acceptable!

Parking: Free Parking is available at the Sovereign Bank Arena (81 Hamilton Avenue, Trenton) in Lot #1. You can then board a free bus to take you to the State House. The lot will open at 10:00 a.m. Buses will run from 10:30 a.m. – 11:45 a.m. and then return you to your car when the rally is over.

Camden-Trenton Light Rail River Line: If you are taking this train, you should exit at the Hamilton Street stop. You can then quickly walk to the Sovereign Bank Arena to receive free transportation. See above.

NJ Transit: Members arriving at the Trenton Train Terminal will have access to shuttles to the Sovereign Bank Arena, where free transportation will then bring you to the State House. Keep your eyes open for "greeters" wearing red shirts that say "Rally Staff." They will direct you to the shuttle.
