What ODS has learned about remote learning

- ❖ It is changing minute to minute
- ❖ Remote learning has removed some of the traditional barriers, but has added additional ones
- ❖ There are learning disparities among students
 - ❖ Environmental: Technology, wifi, home culture and distractions
 - ❖ Disabled community has known this all along: visual vs. verbal learners, variations in speed of processing, focus and distractibility

What ODS has learned about remote learning

- Student survey highlighted key concern was ability to access faculty
- Students also looking for transparency and connections to the course content and what is going on within this global crisis
- Awareness of how proctoring software impacts the student experience
- Faculty survey highlighted desire for more connection to our office, particularly related to resources with exam administration

UDL Best Practices – Per Students

- ❖ Access to Power Points before & during lectures, and recorded lectures reinforced covered material
- ❖ Weekly skill building quizzes
 - ❖ Not punitive
 - ❖ Creates opportunity to identify material/concepts to review
- ❖ Scaffolding of assignments
 - ❖ Helps with keeping track of assignments
 - ❖ Provides feedback for improvement
- ❖ Ability to backwards navigate exam
- ❖ Instructors who positively discuss ODS & accommodations create a "safe space" for students with disabilities

Remote Strategies for Faculty

- ❖ Ask students if there are any barriers to remote learning
 - Provide a current syllabus that reflects remote learning
- ❖ Provide students with a “map” and directions of LMS – Canvas
- ❖ Confirm receipt of LOA
- ❖ If you are opening an exam for 24 hours, set timed parameters
 - ❖ 24 hours with ability to sign in/off for a period of up to x minutes may be an option
 - ❖ "Clock" reflects additional minutes for the student with extended test time
 - ❖ If no time parameter is established, student with extended time have a 36 hour or more test window

ODS Challenges

- ❖ Supporting "zoom" fatigue and streamlining our support and message
- ❖ Managing breaks without time penalty
 - ❖ Discussing how students use the break
- ❖ Replicate in-class test environment
- ❖ Coordinating online exam proctoring
